Dr. Marvin Deversi will be the new executive director at Education Y

As of February 1, 2023, Dr. Marvin Deversi will be the new managing director at EDUCATION Y. He replaces Marek Wallenfels, who joined the team of the Bertelsmann Stiftung in September 2022 as their director (Education and Next Generation).

With the 31-year-old from Bochum, EDUCATION Y gains an expert in further development and digitization of organizational structures. Most recently, he was head of the corporate development department at BARMER health insurance. With a doctorate in economics, he advised companies in the field of evidence-based human resource management and conducted research at the universities of Munich, Cologne, and Chicago.
